



KINDER LOTTERY 2010

WHAT IT IS

The Kinder Lottery is the system we use to admit as many kindergartners as possible in to our Extended Day Program (3PM – 6PM). This is not a necessary step to register for KinderCare (8AM – 11:30 or 11:30 – 3PM).

HOW IT WORKS

In July we will conduct a Lottery. We will pull a pre-determined number of names at random for each school. The children selected will be admitted to the Extended Day Program, in addition to being enrolled in our KinderCare Program. Your admission means you will consistently have a spot in the program through 5th grade.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO

You must submit your child's name to the Lottery by June 30th. A representative from Extended Day will be present during Sibling or New Student Registration and you may sign-up at that time. If you are not able to register or sign-up at that time you can contact us at the district office via phone, fax, E-Mail, or a personal visit.

WHEN TO DO IT

As mentioned, you may sign-up during the April registration dates (April 13th, 14th, 21st, and 22nd) or you can contact us at the district office. If you do not register and submit your child's name to us, unfortunately, you will not be able to partake in the Lottery for Extended Day. You may, however, still register for the KinderCare Program.

AND THEN WHAT?

After the Lottery is conducted you will be notified of the results. If you make it in you will be contacted via phone by July 31st. If your name is not pulled, you will be notified by mail or E-Mail. If you are not selected, **YOU MUST CONTACT US TO BE ADDED TO THE GENERAL WAITING LIST.** You will **NOT** be automatically added.
